Tracey Lien 2010 Media Super Journalist of the Year

Tracey Lien from the University of Technology, Sydney, has won the Media Super Student Journalist of the Year Award for 2010 for her work, "[The Rise and Fallout of Red Ant](#)".

Tracey Lien's winning print article tracks the inside story of inter-business transactions that led the company's sudden demise. Judges said Tracey has taken what could have been just another tale of corporate collapse into compelling reading.

"Her gritty determination with fact-checking, interviewing and leg-work to uncover the maze behind the Red Ant Enterprises shows real commitment to obtaining an accurate account of the company's demise."

The announcement was made at the Walkley Young Australian Journalist of the Year Awards in Sydney on June 23.

Tracey will receive a ticket to the 55th Walkley Awards, to be held in early December in Melbourne.

Open to all tertiary students studying journalism, communications and media-related degrees who have not previously worked full-time in the media, the Media Super Student Journalist of the Year Award recognises student journalism across print, radio, television and online.

Students were encouraged to enter an example of their best work, to be judged by a panel of journalists. The judges were: **Bernard Bowen**, news director, ABC QLD; **Alison Aprhys**, freelance journalist and photographer; and **Robin Jacklin**, former deputy news editor for the ABC in Melbourne.
